LAMBERT AIRPORT INVITES YOU TO ATTEND A NOISE AND MASTER PLAN PUBLIC WORKSHOP MARCH 25

Lambert-St. Louis International Airport invites members of the public to attend a public workshop to hear about current and possible future methods for reducing noise impacts on surrounding communities as well as other elements of the Airport's Master Plan and Noise Compatibility Studies.

The workshop is scheduled from 6-8 p.m., Thursday, March 25, in the City Council Chambers of St. Charles City Hall, 200 N. 2nd St., Fourth Floor.

Information planned to be discussed includes:

- A review of the existing and future baseline noise exposure contours
- A review of the current status of the 1995 Noise Compatibility Program measures and recommended updates to the program
- A review of airport terminal space program scenarios, assumptions and results
- Analysis of collateral-land development potentials including general market analysis and specific attributes of each collateral development area
- Airport demand capacity and facility requirements

Experts will be on hand for informal small-group and one-on-one discussions to answer questions and explain study findings to-date. No formal presentations are scheduled.
