

6.10 WILD AND SCENIC RIVERS

Based on information published on the National Park Service website as of March 14, 2006, there are no Wild and Scenic Rivers designated within the State of Utah or within the State of Nevada.⁸⁰ The Verde River, located in central Arizona between Flagstaff and Phoenix, is the only national Wild and Scenic River designated within the State of Arizona. Segments of the Virgin River, determined to be potentially eligible for consideration as a national wild and scenic river, are located outside of the initial area of investigation. The Verde River is also located outside of the proposed replacement airport study area; therefore, the construction and operation of the proposed replacement airport would have no impact on rivers designated under the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act.⁸¹
